WALKING TRAIL**

Apex P.A. Heuston Lookout

Apex P.A. Heuston Lookout Park was formerly farmland which was donated to the community by the estate of P.A. Heuston to be used as a lookout.

The Apex Club of Singleton in association with Singleton Council developed the site for both locals and visitors to enjoy.

The walking tracks, associated structures and re-vegetation works were carried out by Green Corps in conjunction with Singleton Council between October 2005 and April 2006.

Green Corps is an Australian Government development and environmental training program for young people. It provides young people with an opportunity to preserve and restore Australia's natural environment and cultural heritage.

Hunter River Walks

► VIEWING PLATFORM – 600m RETURN

The viewing platform is situated 60m above the Hunter River and looks west towards the mines at Warkworth. Flood plains and agricultural land can be observed in the foreground.



► GREEN CORPS LOOP WALK - 3.2km RETURN

The loop walk descends down to and follows the Hunter River for 400m. From there the track meets the Old Crossing Road and Hambledon Hill Road which leads back to the car park.

Each walk has steep sections with grades of approximately 20% or 1 in 5. The walk to the Hunter River falls 90m in 550m. A suitable fitness level is required.

► RIVER WALK – 1.1km RETURN

The river walk descends 90m down to the Hunter River, changes in vegetation type can be observed during the transition as subtle changes in the microclimate influence dominant species.
